# DR. SOPHIA DZIEGIELEWSKI, LISW

Dr. Sophia F. Dziegielewski, LISW, is a Professor in the School of Social Work at the University of Cincinnati (UC), Ohio. She is also the Editor of the Journal of Social Service Research. Educational qualifications include her MSW and PhD in Social Work from Florida State University, Tallahassee, FL. Dr. Dziegielewski is a Licensed Independent Social Worker (LISW) in the State of Ohio. Prior to arriving at UC, she was Chairperson for the University of Central Florida Human Subjects Review Board, where she presided over all human subjects research at this large (43,000 students) metropolitan university. In addition to her duties as Dean of the School of Social Work at UC (2004-2008), she also served as Chair of the UC IRB, Behavioral Science Review Board in 2006 and was a board member until 2008. She has also been active in clinical practice maintaining current license in her field as well as serving as an expert witness in the courts. In the national magazine *Social Worker Today* (2003), a feature story about Dr. Dziegielewski referred to her as a "legend" in her field. She is the recipient of numerous awards, and supports her research and practice activity with over 119 publications, including seven textbooks, 79 articles, numerous book chapters and over 500 workshops and community presentations.

## PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

### **IT'S MORE THAN JUST MEDICATIONS: PSYCHO-PHARMACOLOGY IN ADULTS AND ADOLESCENTS; WHAT EVERY SOCIAL WORKER NEEDS TO KNOW**

Social work and other professionals employed in the counseling environment often help to address the needs of adult clients taking prescribed medications. These professionals do not prescribe medications; however, they must be aware of the therapeutic effects and possible problems that can result from medication intervention. In this era of managed behavioral health care less emphasis is being placed on interpersonal practice as the "sole" treatment modality. Understanding psychotropic medication usage has become a practice reality. This seminar is designed to provide non-prescribing professionals with an overview of issues related directly to the benefits and problems that can occur when using selected psychotropic medications with adults.

### **DSM-IV-TR IN ACTION: THE SPECIFICS IN PROCESS AND APPLICATION WITH ADULTS, ADOLESCENTS AND CHILDREN**

This workshop is designed to cover the basics for learning the changes and practical implications of the DSM-IV-TR in regards to social work assessment and practice strategy. Particular emphasis is placed on understanding the use and misuse of the DSM-IV-TR within the mental health profession. An overview of diagnosis and treatment modalities for social work professionals based on behavioral-based practice principles will be stressed.

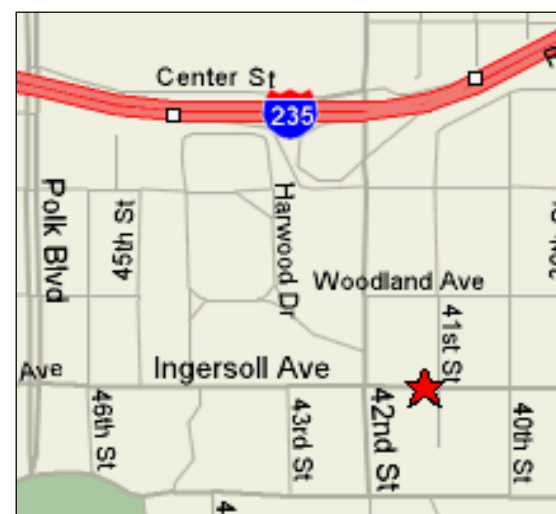
